

PlayStation Network has fallen under a new hack. Users are advised to change their e-mail address of registration.

It is a new hard day for the Japanese company. The hackers exploited a new fault of security which allowed them to change the passwords of the users of the PSN, simply with their e-mail address and their date of birth (found during the previous attack).

It is strongly recommended to the users of the PSN to create a new e-mail address, which will serve exclusively for the network (and to modify the parameters of their account consequently).

Because of this new problem, Sony had to put some of its pages off-line. " The persons who try to change their password on Playstation.com or Qriocity.com cannot make it at the moment, because of operations of maintenance about which we do not still know how long they will last ", declared Sony in a communiqué.

Nevertheless, it is always possible to connect in the PSN via its games consoles.
